

Notice to the referral doctor

The **Centre Médical du Tilleul** aims to become a Center of excellence, responding in the most efficient way possible to the needs of the referral doctors.

This objective is achieved through a **code of ethics** that guides the actions of the medical team.

1. Quality of care

One of the goals of the Medical Center is to provide a large array of personalized care best suited to current and future medical requirements. While still maintaining a human touch, care-giving must adapt according to the patient needs, keeping the well-being of the patient as the utmost priority. The most appropriate and effective method of care will be evaluated over time.

2. Availability and continuity of care

The medical team of the CMT is committed to be available to reply to the questions and needs of the referral doctors in order to ensure the best possible treatment.

3. Structure

The CMT's medical team is committed to participating in the continued networking of referral doctors. The CMT doctors desire to invest themselves by actively participating in the meetings of the Glem or Dodecagroups. In the near future the CMT intends to have conference facilities made available to the referral doctors.

4. Confraternity

The CMT's medical team is committed to respect the confraternity rules. Internal references (opinions of other colleagues of the Center without the referral doctor's consent) as well as any unnecessary summoning of patients must be avoided as much as possible. Correspondence must be quick and must use the modern methods of transmission (Medibridge...). The Center's Medical Council will evaluate these confraternity rules periodically. The Medical Council will be composed of specialist doctors working in the CMT and referral doctors or their representatives. All interested referral doctors are welcome at the Medical Council's meetings.
